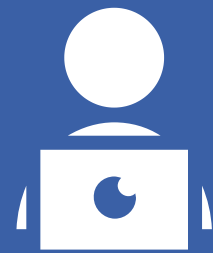

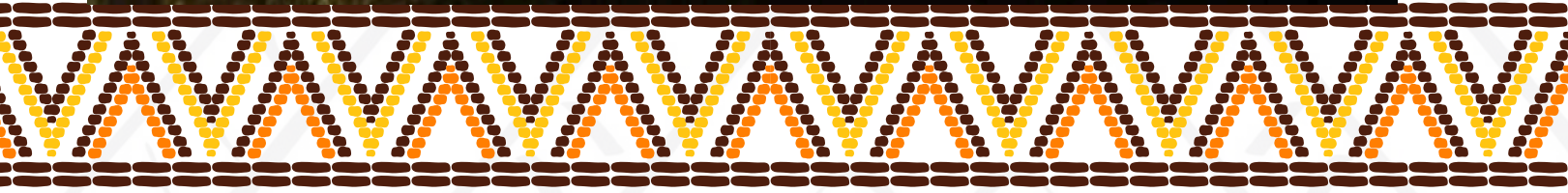

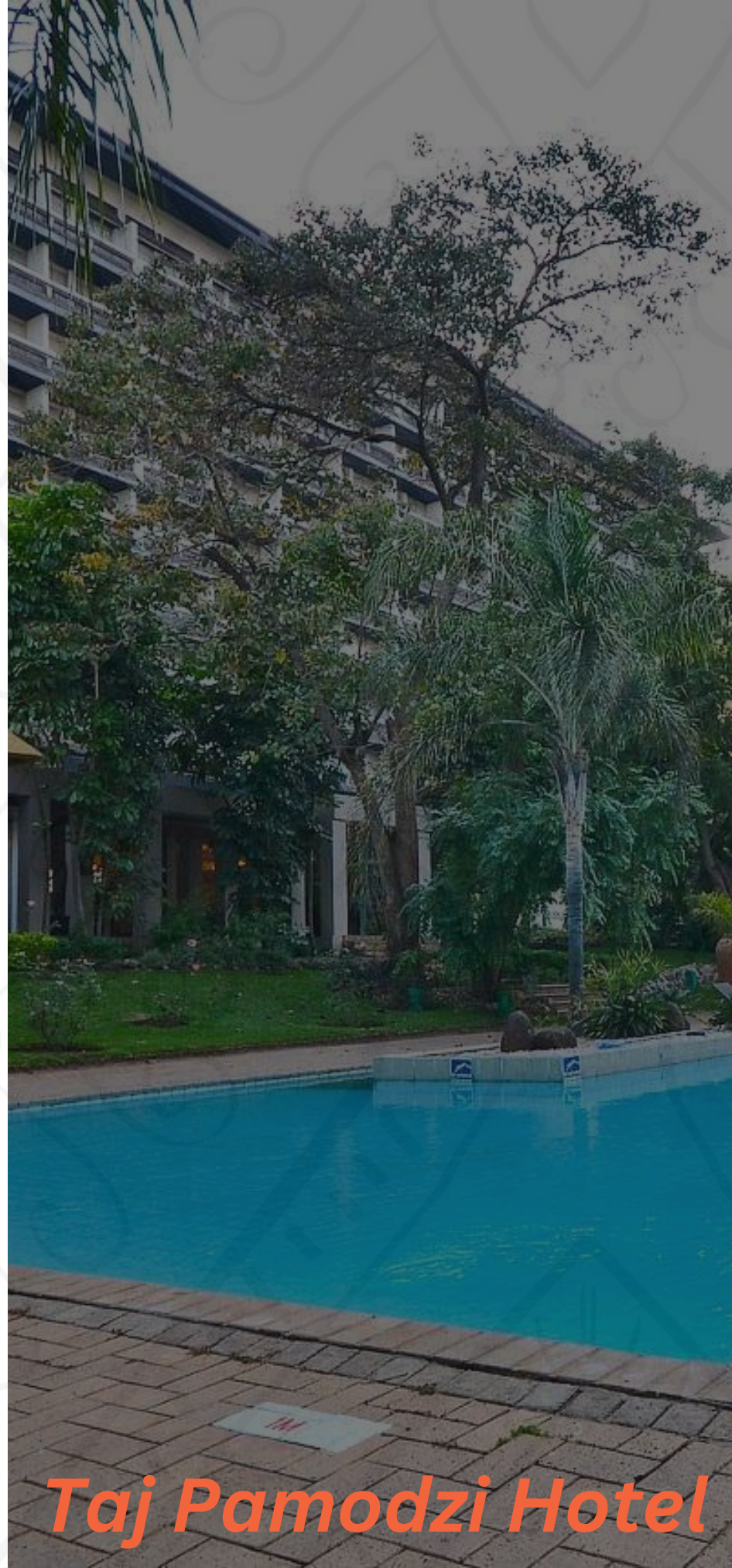
# INTRODUCTION

The event is meant to promote an affordable, free, open, resilient, and inclusive internet for all in line with global best practices. The stakeholders include civil society, academia, regulators, media, law enforcement, lawyers, policymakers, legislators, service providers, technologists, government agencies and ministries etc to share experiences, policy directions, and legislative processes and to network on issues of digitalization. The Lusaka Internet Meet-Up is also open for participation from interested groups and partners from abroad who are keen on supporting the in-country event.
